The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the
Honourable Paul Martin, will lead the Canadian Relegation to the
United Nations Conference on Trade and Development which opens in
Geneva, Switzerland, on March 23, and will attend the opening
session of Ministers from the participating countries. It is
expected that Mr. Martin will proceed to Geneva over the weekend
of March 21-22 returning at the end of the week. The Permanent
Head of the Canadian Delegation is Mr. L. Dana Wilgress.\*

The Conference, which will continue until mid-June, is being convened by the United Nations to consider and seek solutions for the trade and development problems of the less developed countries of the world. All members of the United Nations and specialized agencies have been invited and it is estimated that some 1,500 participants and observers will attend. On March 23 the Conference will be opened formally by the United Nations Secretary General, U Thant. The Secretary of State for External Affairs will be among the speakers addressing the Conference the following day.
