(Public Bills)

The Order being read for the second reading and reference to the Standing Committee on Justice and Legal Affairs of Bill C-240, An Act respecting Sir John A. Macdonald Day;

By unanimous consent, it was ordered,—That the Order for second reading and reference to the Standing Committee on Justice and Legal Affairs of Bill C-240, An Act respecting Sir John A. Macdonald Day, be discharged, that the Bill be withdrawn and that the subject-matter of the Bill be referred to the Standing Committee on Justice and Legal Affairs.

Consideration was resumed at the report stage of Bill C-44, An Act to amend the Senate and House of Commons Act, the Salaries Act and the Parliamentary Secretaries Act, as reported (with amendments) from the Standing Committee on Miscellaneous Estimates and as reprinted in accordance with Mr. Speaker's decision of Wednesday, April 23, 1975.

Debate was resumed on the motion of Mr. Sharp, seconded by Mrs. Sauvé,—That Bill C-44, An Act to amend the Senate and House of Commons Act, the Salaries Act and the Parliamentary Secretaries Act, be amended by striking out lines 11 to 49 at page 2 and lines 1 to 20 at page 3 and substituting the following:

“(2) Section 34 of the said Act is further amended by adding thereto the following subsections:

Adjustment
of sessional
allowance

“(3) For the twelve month period commencing January 1, 1976 and for each twelve month period thereafter, there shall be paid to every member of the Senate and House of Commons, for the sessions of Parliament in each such period, a sessional allowance at the rate per annum that is obtained by multiplying the sessional allowance payable to each such member for the twelve month period immediately preceding
