ARDA REPORT ON POVERTY AMONG INDIANS

Motion No. 27—Mr. Orlikow:

That an Order of the House do issue for a copy of the Report prepared by ARDA dealing with poverty among the Indians of Canada.

Mr. Russell C. Honey (Parliamentary Secretary to Minister of Forestry and Rural Development): Mr. Speaker, there is no report as referred to in this notice of motion. The reference may be to a working paper designed for interdepartmental purposes which is confidential and not for publication.

I have spoken to the hon. member for Winnipeg North this morning, and I understand that in view of this information he will consent to the removal of the notice of motion from the order paper.

PASSPORT APPLICATION, JAMES EARL RAY

Motion No. 31—Mr. Woolliams:

That an Order of the House do issue for a copy of all applications and/or other documents leading up to the granting of a passport and/or passports to Mr. James Earl Ray, the alleged assassin of Martin Luther King.

Hon. C. M. Drury (President of the Treasury Board): Mr. Speaker, the Minister of Justice has already informed the house that this case, involving a passport application to which my hon. friend has referred, is now before the courts. The matter is therefore *sub judice* at this time, but we expect that the documents in question will become public knowledge in the course of judicial process during the trial. Therefore, with great respect, I would ask the hon. member to withdraw the motion.
