even of a single individual eating her bread and not doing her work, or doing it superficially. Let every one who has the status of a Minister make it a matter of conscience to do a Minister's work. By the great oath which he registered in Heaven on his ordination day, by the undoubted commandment of God's word, by the present exigences of the Church, he is bound to give himself up exclusively to the duties of his profession."

Whether or not the labour of these fifteen months may have been productive of good results, or have been like water spilled upon the ground, remains to be seen. Whether or not your Committee will have it in their power to point in future years to a marked and satisfactory increase of liberality among our adherents, depends not on feeble human agency, but on Him "who giveth the increase." It will be something for us at least to say, "we have done what we could."
