IV. No person shall throw water, dust, ashes, soot, filth or dirt of any kind in the streets; every person is to have the street before his house kept net and clean at all times, under a penalty of five shillings for every offence.

V. No person shall be permitted to pile wood in the streets, nor shall any one leave carts, calashes, carriages, or casks to encumber the streets, under a penalty of five shillings. Every person disobeying the order of any Commissioner of the Peace to remove a nuisance or encumbrance found on the said person's portion of the street, shall pay five shillings every time he refuses to obey the order. It shall be lawful for any Commissioner or for any person appointed by the Commissioners, to remove all encumbrances left in the streets, and may order them to be laid in any place within or without the walls so as not to incommode any person; he or she on whose part of the street such encumbrance is found shall pay a fine of ten shillings, over and above the expence of removal.

VI. No person shall be permitted to keep hogs in any pen, yard or court, so near any street as to be offensive to the neighbours, or to people passing, under a penalty of twenty shillings and to remove them immediately.

VII. No person shall exercise the trade of a butcher after the first day of December next without a licence signed by two Commissioners of the Peace under pain of ten shillings for every day they may have continued the trade of a butcher without licence; every butcher shall keep the place where he kills his cattle clean and as free as possible from offensive smell, and if the smell of any such place shall become at any time offensive, and complaint thereof be made to a

Commissioner.
