Reports of committees received---Notices of motions---General business.

SPECIAL MEETINGS.

13.—May be called on a requisition signed by any three Captains, and addressed to the officer Commanding specifying the object or which such meeting is desired, and to the discussion of which the meeting when called shall strictly confine itself. The Commanding officer may at any time call the officers together for the consideration of matters affecting the welfare, or good order of the Battalion. Three days previous notice of all meetings, when called must be given.

COMMITTEES.

14.—There will be a permanent Finance Committee, consisting of the Lieut. Colonel, one Major, one Caj tain, the Paymaster and the Adjutant, which will exercise supervision and control over the Battalion funds, and order such disbursements as may from time to time, be be necessary. The Paymaster reporting such for approval at the quarterly meeting immediately following after. Committees for special purposes may be appointed whenever found necessary.

MESS DINNER.

15.—Should it be deemed advisable to have a Mess Dinner during the year, the period therefor will be
