WANT MILITARY CANTINE SURGEONS NOT SATISFIED. Col. Forthingham, A.M.C., Speaks of Convention's Action at Detroit.

Is the military canteen, which saw its passing in Canada some four years ago, and later disappeared as an army institution of Uncle Sam's, in each case thru the exertions of the W. C. T. U., to be restored once more?

There appears to be some prospect of this, since the W. C. T. U. has returned on Saturday from attending the five days' convention of the Military Surgeons of the United States at Detroit.

There were at the convention about one hundred army surgeons from all over the United States, while Great Britain, several European countries and Japan had also accredited representatives.

Major Echlin of the Second Field Hospital, Ottawa, was present for Canada's military surgeons.

In passing the resolution it was pointed out by some of the speakers that canteens, being under strict military control, could be closed down at any time when the necessity of conducting was found to be objectionable.

It was also pointed out that in support of the men to have been often had the effect of causing whiskey to be quietly introduced into the canteens.

Attended Rejuvenation. The most interesting person attending the convention was the Japanese Imperial navy. For several reasons, as mentioned by the Canadian delegates, was a notable figure.

He was Admiral Togo's chief surgeon during the war, and it was his fingers that dressed the wounds of the Japanese soldiers.

There was also present a Chinese naval surgeon, as well as two military attachés.
