The friction between the fruit dealers and the Grand Trunk Railway is another forcible argument in favor of the establishment of a suitable fruit market. The fruit trade is expanding very rapidly. Fruit growers in every section of the province regard Toronto as their natural market. It will be folly if we do not facilitate in every way we can the centralization of the fruit trade in Toronto. Whether the St. Lawrence market would be a satisfactory site is perhaps debatable. A site in Lakeside Park would certainly be more commodious and more centrally situated both for the receiving of goods by cars and steamboats and for distribution throughout the city. The fact that the Grand Trunk collected in the neighborhood of \$8000 in tolls last year from the fruit that was sold in its building at the foot of Yonge-street is proof enough that a well-equipped fruit market would be a paying venture for the city to undertake. It is rather late in the season to get a new structure ready for this year, but the project should be discussed now when the necessity for better accommodation is so apparent.

A TRANSPORTATION SCANDAL.

If the war between the United States and Spain were being carried on in the Pacific Ocean alone, the Western American railways would not need to worry about their losses in the rate war. Nine weeks ago the United States Congress voted the sum of six million dollars for the transportation of troops and supplies, but this amount proved insufficient, as fifteen million dollars have already been expended for this purpose. The General Deficiency bill which has just gone through the House of Congress provides for an expenditure of \$53,000,000 for transportation. Of this amount nine million dollars is to go to make up the difference between the six million dollars voted before and the fifteen million dollars expended. The remaining \$44,000,000 is for transportation during the next six months, and the various railways are already striving to see how much they can get of it. A considerable portion of this vast sum will go to pay the owners of transport ships, but the railways expect to get a large part of it as they did of the fifteen million dollars already expended.
