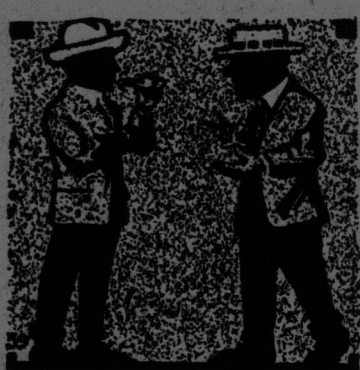

Demonstrations against the war are said to be increasing in number and violence, especially in Vienna and at points in Bohemia, mobs are reported to have sacked storehouses in which were stocks of provisions for the army.
