



N. B. Department Report Shows Total of \$1,118,798

Stumpage Decline is \$198,000— Detailed List of Payments Given

FREDERICTON, March 11 - The net revenue of the province of New Brunswick from the Department of Lands and Mines for the fiscal year ending Oct. 31, 1925, showed a falling off of more than \$200,000 from the pre-ceding year, according to the report of the department tabled in the Legisla-tive Assembly this afternoon by Hon. C. D. Richards, Minister of Lands and

Mines.

The net revenue was \$1,118,798.35 as compared with \$1,322,631.38 for 1924. The biggest decrease was in stumpage, which showed a falling off of about \$198,000. Timber bonuses showed a big increase, being more than \$67,000 ahead of those of the previous year.

The Bathurst Co., Ltd., was the heaviest contributor in stumpage fees with \$95,909. The Richards Manufacturing Company was second with \$57,022 with the Fraser Company third with \$50,056.
