Lines Worse Than the  
Reign of Terror

Archangel, Oct. 22.—(Correspondence of The Associated Press.)—The fast bleeding to death through a reign of terror which is worse than that of the French Revolution, and it is time the nations of the earth came to put down one of the world's greatest evils, President Nicholas Tschalikovsky of the Provisional Government of the North, told a correspondent of The Associated Press today.
