FIXED COURSE.

The Fixed Course in the Second Year comprehends the following Departments and Sub-departments:—

Classics; Mathematics; History; French; Elements of Mineralogy and Geology; Logic, Metaphysics, and Ethics.

VARIABLE COURSE.

The Variable Course in the Second Year comprehends the following Departments and Sub-departments:—

Classics; Mathematics; French and German; History; Elements of Mineralogy and Geology; Elements of Natural History; Logic, Metaphysics, and Ethics; Hebrew.

German is necessary for those who may substitute "Modern Languages" for "Classics" after this year.

Those who take Hebrew may omit French and German.

The elements of Natural History are necessary for those who did not take them in the First Year.
