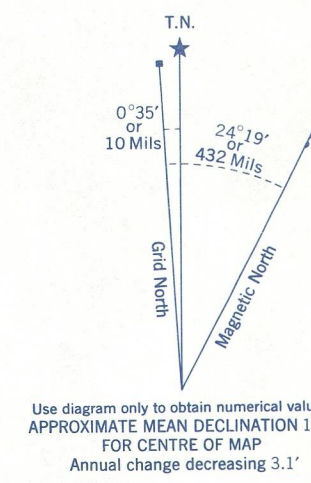

THE FOLLOWING GRID REFERENCE IS A SAMPLE ONLY
AND DOES NOT REFER TO A POINT ON THIS MAP

REFERENCE POINT CHURCH (see above)

EASTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point. Estimate tenths of a square from this line nearest to point. 97 5 975

NORTHING: Read number on grid line immediately below point. Estimate tenths of a square from this line nearest to point. 98 1 981
