OBSTETRICS.

· Professor Meek and Dr. Balfour.

Teaching in this subject will be made as practical as possible.

By use of Mannikin, the student can make himself familiar with Mechanism of Labor, the use of Forceps, Version, etc.

In the Lying-in Ward in the Hospital, the student will have opportunities for studying the management of cases during the different stages of Labor.

The importance of *Election* in Obstetric Surgery will receive particular attention.

During the Session, a course of lectures on Diseases of Children will be given by Dr. Balfour, lecturer on Midwifery and Diseases of Children.

GYNÆCOLOGY.

Professor Eccles.

The aim and object of this course will be to make it as thorough and practical as possible. The student's attention will first be directed to all the anatomical and physiological facts bearing on Gynæcological practice. He will then be taught the proper methods of investigating cases and the use of the various instruments required in their diagnosis and treatment.

All the diseases embraced under this head will be brought before the student.

At the London General Hospital, Clinical Instruction will be given to the 3rd and 4th year students, and to the graduating class special training in the practical part of the subject.

Pelvic and Abdominal Surgery, and the Clinical Aspect of Abdominal Tumours, will be an important feature of the course.
