

McDONALD, HERBERT STONE, M.A. [*South Leeds.*]

Grandf. came to Am. from Perthshire, Scot., about 1787. Only surviving s. of the late Hon. John McDonald, of Gananoque, Ont., who sat in the L.O. of U.C., and also in that of Can. B. at Gananoque, 23 Feb., 1842. Ed. at the Gananoque Grammar Sch., at the Preparatory Sch. of Queen's College, and at the University of Queen's College, where he graduated B.A., 1859, and M.A., 1861. M., June, 1864, Emma Matilda, third dau. of David Jones, Esq., Registrar for Leeds, who represented that County for several years in the U.O. Assembly. Called to the Bar, Easter Term, 1863. Is Grand Master of the Orange Association for the Province of Eastern Ontario; Presdt. of the Young Men's Christian Association of Brockville, and Paymaster 41st Batt. "Brockville" V. R. Has been Deputy Judge for Leeds and Grenville. First returned to Parlt. for present seat, by acclamation, at last g. e. A Liberal Conservative.—*Brockville, Ont.*
