An Act to repeal the 35th and 36th sections of the "Fishery Act," as respects Lakes Erie and St. Clair, and their tributaries.

HEREAS by the thirty-fifth and thirty-sixth sections of the Preamble. Fishery Act, it is enacted that no Maskinongé, Pickerel, nor Black Bass, shall be caught, bought, sold, or found in the possession of any person between the fifteenth day of March, and the fifteenth day of 5 May : And whereas it is expedient to repeal the said sections, in so far as they affect Lakes Erie and St. Clair, and their tributaries; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows :

I. The thirty-fifth and thirty-sixth sections of the said Fishery Act Cortain secshall not extend or apply to Lakes Erie and St. Clair, and their tribu- tions not to 10 taries, or to fish caught therein. 11
