## An Act to amend the laws relating to Turnpike Roads in the neighbourhood of Montreal.

HEREAS injustice arises from the operation of the laws regu- Preamble. lating the Turnpike Roads in the neighbourhood of the City of Montreal which compel the payment of double tolls by persons who have to pass any of the toll-gates on the said roads a short time before 5 midnight of one day, and to pass them again in returning at any time during the next day, whilst those who pass and repass at any other times in the course of one and the same day, although at more extended intervals, are only compelled to pay one toll both for passing and returning: And whereas it is desirable to remedy this injustice; Therefore Her 10 Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Act passed in the Notwithstandsession held in the fourth and fifth years of Her Majesty's reign, chap- ing 4 & 5 V.c. tered thirty-five, and intituled "An Act to amend the Ordinance of the paying full Legislature of the late Province of Lower Canada providing for the im- toll on passing

- 15 provement of the Roads in the neighbourhood of the City of Montreal," any gateway, or in any other Act or Law relating to the said roads, any traveller or the following other person passing any toll-gates on the said roads with or without a day but not horse, carriage, beasts of burden, or other animals whatsoever, shall later. hereafter, if it be his intention to return, receive a pass-ticket from the
- 2<sup>0</sup> toll collector at each toll-gate upon paying the toll in full on passing, and the said ticket shall enable him again to pass free on his return, provided such return take place on the same day or the day following, but not later.

II. This Act shall be deemed a public Act.
