BILL.

An Act to constitute the Electoral County of Sherbrooke into a separate Municipality, and to establish a Registry Office therein.

WHEREAS it is expedient, by reason of the extent of the present Preamble. Municipal County of Sherbrooke, that the same should be divided into less extensive Municipalities and Registration Districts, Be it therefore, &c.

5 That the Townships of Supton, Melbourne, Windsor, Stoke, with the exception of the first, second, third, fourth and fifth Ranges thereof; Brompton, and the Gore thereof, with the exception of that part of Brompton lying south-east of the line between Lots numbers twenty-six and twenty-seven in the fourth and fifth Ranges of the said Township of Brompton, shall
10 be constituted and form a separate Municipality under the name of "*The Municipality of Richmond.*"

Municipality of Richmond constituted and described.

15 II. That the sixth, seventh, eighth, ninth, tenth, eleventh, twelfth, thirteenth and fourteenth Ranges of Stoke shall, for all Municipal purposes, be united with the Township of Windsor, which shall together have one Poll, in the most convenient and central place for the inhabitants of the said United Townships: and that the Gore of Brompton shall continue united to the Township of Melbourne: and that the portions of the Townships of Brompton and Stoke, not hereby included within the limits of the Municipality of Richmond, shall, for all Municipal purposes, be annexed to, and held to
20 form parts of, and the inhabitants thereof shall vote in, the Townships of Orford and Ascot respectively.

Part of Stoke united to Windsor.
Gore of Brompton to remain united to Melbourne.
Parts of Brompton and Stoke united to Orford and Ascot.

25 III. That the first seven Ranges of the Township of Supton shall form an entire Township under the same name, and shall have a Poll at the Village of Danville; and the remaining eight Ranges of the said Township of Supton are hereby detached therefrom, and erected and constituted into a separate Township, under the name of the *Township of Cleveland*, and shall have a Poll at the Village of Richmond.

Township of Cleveland constituted.

30 IV. That the qualified inhabitants of the said Township of Cleveland, shall, at the next annual Election, elect two Councillors to represent the same, and the Council of the said Municipality of Richmond shall determine by lot which of the said Councillors shall vacate his seat at the election next thereafter.

Two Councillors for Cleveland.

35 V. That the Municipal Councillors representing the said several Townships, in the Council of the Municipality of Sherbrooke, shall be members of, and represent the said Townships in the Council of the Municipality of Richmond, to all intents and purposes as if they had been originally elected therefor: And the said Council of the Municipality

Certain Members of Council of Sherbrooke to be members of that of Richmond.
