An Act granting to Her Majesty certain sums required for defraying certain expenses of the Civil Government for the year 1851, and certain other expenses connected with the Public Service.

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN,—

WHEREAS by Messages from His Excellency the Right Honourable JAMES, EARL OF ELGIN AND KINCARDINE, Governor General of British America, and Captain General and Governor-in-Chief in and over this Province of Canada, bearing date respectively the twenty-third day of June, and the sixth day of August, in the present year, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-one, and the Estimates accompanying the same, laid before the Houses of the Provincial Legislature, it appears that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Civil Government of this Province for the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-one, not otherwise provided for by law, and also for defraying certain contingencies of the Public Service connected with the Public Works, and for other purposes in the said Messages and Estimates mentioned: May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted, &c.,

Preamble.

That from and out of any unappropriated moneys forming part of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of this Province there shall and may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole three hundred and seventy-nine thousand, two hundred and sixty-two pounds, eight shillings and two-pence currency, for defraying the expenses of the Civil Government of this Province, for the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-one, and the other expenses and charges set forth in the Schedule to this Act.

II. And be it enacted, That from and out of any unappropriated moneys forming part of the Jesuits' Estates Fund, there shall and may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding four thousand pounds, towards the support of certain Educational Institutions in Lower Canada, as mentioned in the Schedule aforesaid.

III. And be it enacted, That the due application of the moneys hereby appropriated shall be accounted for to Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors, through the
