Costs of suing for the same, to be levied by Warrant of Distress and Sale of the Goods of the Offender; one half of every such Penalty to be given to the Informer, and the other half to the Fire-applied; Wardens, to be applied by them in repairs or additions of the Fire Engine; and other Implements herein before provided for, and to be accounted for by them to their Successors in Office—provided that all Fines, Penalties, and Forfeitures, shall within ten days be sued for within ten days after the offence shall after the offence. be committed, and not after.

CAP. II.

An Act in addition to, and amendment of, an Act for expediting the Printing of the Laws of this Island.
