I am to-day forwarding to you under separate cover three tracings covering right of way of the Grand Trank Pacific Branch Lines Company on the above line, together with two partial tracings which after registration are to be submitted, one to the Department of the Interior and the other to your Department. You will note that all tracings have already been approved by the Department of the Interior and also by Mr. A. C. Garner, Chief Surveyor, Land Titles Office, Regina. The partial tracing which is marked for your Department covers all Indian lands on this Branch, and it is possible that you will find that the areas shown thereon differ somewhat from those shown on original plan which is on file with your Department. These discrepancies can only be explained on account of the insufficient survey originally made, and any differences will have to be corrected by petition to the Master of Titles for Saskatchewan.
