Dear Sir:

With further reference to the resolutions forwarded to you from Pasqua and Muscowpetung Bands. *on file 23114-2*

The money was voted for by the Bands so as to enable the Indians to purchase food and clothing for their own use this winter, practically it was a relief measure and very necessary.

The roads on the reserves were all in bad shape as they had not been repaired for years and the culverts were all broken and washed away.

Also six new dams were built so as to hold a supply of water next spring.

This fall and winter has been ideal for such work as there is practically no frost in the ground.

The Indians have been working on these roads with the expectation of being paid from their own funds.
