The unsigned Affidavit is returned herewith, for completion, and I have again to call your attention to the several outstanding returns of timber cut on this Reserve, and to state that you should lose no time in collecting and transmitting to the Department all outstanding specifications and affidavits connected with timber taken out by the Indians.
