weet the entry of tordish la Tember, home in the larger entity, and the Dominion thereupen spread to the waters of the Pacific. 2 1873, Prince Edward Island for like reasons - a common allegiance to the Crown, a like sunder constitution - completed the expansion of the Dominion by the waters of the Atlantic. Then in 1905, out of the territories in the middle west, already owing allegiance to the Crown, but given for the first time the status of provinces, came Saskatchewan and Alberta, completing the Dominion of Canada from sea to sea as we know it to-day, - one in its unity physically, one in its allegiance to the British Crown, one in its constitution medelled after the British Constitution. 1905: Twenty-two years ago! How many of us realize what this means. In one sense it is true that our Dominion this year celebrates its Diamond Jubilee; in another sense it is even truer, that three years hence, it will be celebrating not its Diamond Jubilee, but the first quarter of a century of its history as a community of provinces extending from coast to coast, and all a part of the oue Dominion; a country in a much fuller and truer sense. There in all history will we witness a more amazing growth: As a country. we are only on the threshold of our existence.

If Canada has grown in the three hundred years of her existence as a white man's possession, and expanded in the one
