Sir:

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 22nd instant with a letter from the Reverend Principal of Keeseekoosie Boarding School, with reference to assistance for two boys, George Kakakeway and Henry Stanley Keshane, who have recently graduated, and in reply I beg to say that in view of the recommendation of the Principal and yourself, you may purchase for each of these boys, provided that they have locations of their own, a yoke of oxen, a set of harness, plow and disc. The usual agreement providing for re-payment of purchase price over and above \$125.00, and other conditions should be signed by each of these boys and a copy sent to the Department to be placed on record.
