Maden, --

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 15th instant giving an outline of the work you are carrying on during the winter months for the uplift of the Indians on the Rama Reserve.

In reply I beg to say that the Department fully appreciates the efforts of yourself and Miss McBain to interest and encourage the Indians to become self-supporting and law abiding citizens. I can assure you that the Department will afford you every assistance and will full any requisitions you may make in the interests of agraculture or domestic science.
