MEMORANDUM FOR THE  
PRIME MINISTER -

Attached is a telegram from Washington regarding the proposed visit to Canada of Count Serge Fleury, also copy of a note from Mr. Hankinson. I think it is a matter that we can manage ourselves. He has visited Canada often and I know him quite well and like him personally. I think he is usually pretty innocuous in anything he says, but his mere presence here would probably be misinterpreted. We declined, some weeks ago, to give a visa to a couple of Attachés of the Embassy in Washington.

Mr. Henry tells me that the French Minister wants an appointment with you shortly.
