BETWEEN -

THE SUPERINTENDENT GENERAL of Indian Affairs, DUNCAN C. SCOTT, of the City of Ottawa, in the Porvince of Ontario, representing the Indian Tribe of the Sliammon Reserve

OF THE FIRST PART

AND -

PEERS, ANDERSON and PLUMMER, Lumbermen of the City of Vancouver, Province of British Columbia.

OF THE SECOND PART

WHEREAS permission has been given to Chief Tom of the Sliammon Tribe of the Province of British Columbia, to cut and carry away the timber from Harwood Island, known as Harwood Island Indian Reserve, Number two.

AND WHEREAS the Indians of the Sliammon Island, petitioned the Indian Department at Ottawa to enter into arrangements to cut and remove the timber from the said Reserve, Number two, in a manner satisfactory to the Department of Indian Affairs.

AND WHEREAS Feers, Anderson and Flummer are willing to purchase from the Department acting for the Indians all the merchantable timber in the said Harwood Island, on the following terms and conditions, namely:-

That the said Party of the Second Part, shall pay to the party of the first Part, the sum of \$1.75 per thousand \$100 per thousand of which is to be paid into the Indian Trust funds, in behalf of the said Sliammon Tribe, and 75¢ per thousand to be paid direct to the Indians for cutting and delivering the said timber on the ground where cut.

AND WHEREAS the Indians have signified their satisfaction with these terms in a petition hereunto attached and marked Exhibit "AA" to this contract.
