- 6. Monte Bello, Que.—Between Papineauville, and the "Manoir de Monte Bello" and on the Presqu'Ile and Squirrel Island interesting outcrops of the Potsdam sandstone occur with many of their surfaces showing ripple-marks and other phenomena of wind and wave action, besides several tracks and trails of marine organisms similar to those described by Sir Richard Owen from the Potsdam of Beauharnois on the St. Lawrence, were observed by Sir William Dawson and the writer during field-days of the Natural History Society of Montreal and the Ottawa Field-Naturalists' Club. These include at least two species, viz. :—
  - 1. Proticinites septem-notatus, Owen.
  - 2. Protichnites lineatus, Owen.
