

xx., 8.—For Satan is to have the nations after the millenium, and there is to be war before the end of the present order of things; but when the end is to be, then the coming of the Son of Man is to be, no man knoweth. The Scriptures state this emphatically, which should check all presumption, idle curiosity and foolish speculation *on* the subject. Matt., xxiv., 36—"But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels of heaven, but my Father only." Our duty is plainly enjoined upon us, "Watch therefore, for ye know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of Man cometh."
