The history of the early settlement of this Township is the same as that of the City of Hamilton which, previous to its incorporation formed part of it. Among the early settlers above the Mountain were Jacob and William Rymal, William Terryberry, Cornelius and Samuel Ryckman, Lewis and Peter Horning, and families named Markle, Hess, Burkholder, Taylor, Neff, and others. Below the mountain were families named Jones, Needham, Lottridge, Gage, Stewart, Bennett, Case, Grosthwaite, Cline, Horning, Aikman, Reynolds, Shearman, Land, Hughson, Springer, Lockwood, Wedge and Dexter. In the year 1815, Wm. Rymal was assessed for 160 acres of cleared land, and Jacob Rymal for 80; William Terryberry 168 acres of arable land; Samuel Ryckman had 26 acres,
