CAP. LIV.

An Act to continue the Act to extend to the Town of Dartmouth the Act to amend the Act to regulate the Assize of Bread.

(Passed the 30th day of March, 1848.)

BE it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That the Act passed in the Sixth Year of Her present Majesty's Reign, entitled, 'An Act to extend to the Town of Dartmouth the Act to amend the Act to regulate the Assize of Bread'—and every matter, clause, and thing, therein contained, shall be continued, and the same are hereby continued for Three years, and thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly.

CAP. LV.

An Act to continue the Acts to regulate the Pilotage of Vessels at the Port of Halifax.

(Passed the 30th day of March, 1848.)

BE it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That the Act passed in the Eleventh Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth, entitled, 'An Act to regulate the Pilotage of Vessels at the Port of Halifax,' and the several Acts passed in the First and Second Years respectively of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, in amendment of, and additional to, the said Act, except so far as the same may be altered or amended by the Acts hereinafter mentioned; also, the Act passed in the Eighth Year of Her present Majesty's Reign, to continue and amend the said Acts, except as altered by the Act hereinafter mentioned; and also, the Act passed in the Tenth Year of Her present Majesty's Reign, to continue and amend the said Acts, shall be continued—and the said several Acts, and every matter, clause, and thing, therein contained, except as before excepted, are hereby continued for Three years, and thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly.
