Preamble.

HEREAS it is expedient to appropriate a further Sum of Money in addition to the sum appropriated by an Act passed in the fifth Year of His Majesty's Reign, Chapter Twenty-eight, and to alter the provisions of the said Act: May it therefore please Your Majesty, that it may be enacted and be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal "certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of £500 granted "the Province of Quebec in North America;" and to make further provision by this Act, in " for the Government of the said Province;" and it is hereby enacted by the addition to £500 granted authority of the same, that it shall be lawful for the Governor, Lieutenant Gov-5, Geo. iv. ernor or Person administering the Government of this Province for the time being, to advance by a Warrant or Warrants under his hand, a sum not exceeding Five hundred pounds Currency, in addition to the like Sum of Five hundred Pounds Currency, appropriated by the aforesaid Act of the fifth year of His Majesty's Reign, Chapter twenty eight, which said sum hereby appropriated
