Resolved, That at such Conference the managers be instructed to acquaint the managers for the House of Assembly that this House do insist on the ninth, eleventh, and twelfth of their amendments to the said Bill, disagreed to by the House of Assembly.

A Message from the House of Assembly, by the Hon. Mr. Haviland :

"Mr. President;

"The House of Assembly do agree to a further Conference, as is desired by the Legislative Council, on the amendments made to the Bill intituled 'An Act for taking the Census of Prince Edward Island,' and have appointed the same Committee who managed the former Conference thereon, a Committee to manage this further Conference."

And the names of the Managers being called over, they went to the Conference; and being returned, reported that they had complied with the instructions given them by this House.

A Message from the House of Assembly, by the Hon. Mr. Haviland :

"Mr. President;

"The House of Assembly have agreed to the amendments made by the Legislative Council to the Bill intituled 'An Act for the preservation of the Alewives Fisheries in this Island," without any amendment."

Resolved, That there be a Call of the House on Friday next, and that the Clerk do notify absent Members.

Adjourned until Monday next, at Eleven o'clock.
