TOBoggING AT PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND.

THE country at Prince Edward Island is very flat, and consequently affords little facility for Toboggining, a good start being indispensable. This has been remedied on the pretty grounds belonging to Government House by the erection of a steep wooden slide at the top of a slight slope leading to the ice, and which gives sufficient impetus to take you 400 to 500 yards. Toboggin parties in Canada are given much in the same way as croquet parties in England, but, if I might presume to give an opinion, offer far more amusement.
