MYSTERIOUS RAIDER "MOEW" HAS AVOIDED BRITISH SHIPS AND RETURNED TO HUN PORT

After Sinking 15 Ships and Laying Mines, One of Which, Says Berlin, Sank the Battleship King Edward VII, the Boat Has Got in "Some" German Port.

Berlin, March 6.—Official announcement was made here today that the German cruiser Moewe arrived Sunday in "some" German port. She had on board a large number of British prisoners and \$200,000 in gold bars.

The vessel brought up the following enemy steamers, the greater part of which were sent as prizes to neutral ports: The British steamships Corbridge, 3,687 tons; Author, 3,496 tons; Trader, 3,568 tons; Ariadne, 3,025 tons; Dromonby, 3,627 tons; Farrington, 3,146 tons; Clan MacFayish, 5,582 tons; ...

IRON CROSSES FOR WHOLE OUTFIT. London, March 6.—An Exchange Telegraph Company despatch from Amsterdam says the Moewe reached Wilhelmshaven Saturday.

Count von Dohna, the Moewe's commander, has been awarded the Iron Cross of the first class and the members of the crew have received the Iron Cross of the second class.

The Moewe, previously made famous by her exploits, has performed one of the most spectacular feats of the war on the seas by reaching a home port in safety.

Part of the gold captured by the Moewe, at least, was taken from the Appan, which put in at Newport News several weeks ago under command of Lieut. Berg, with a German prize crew.

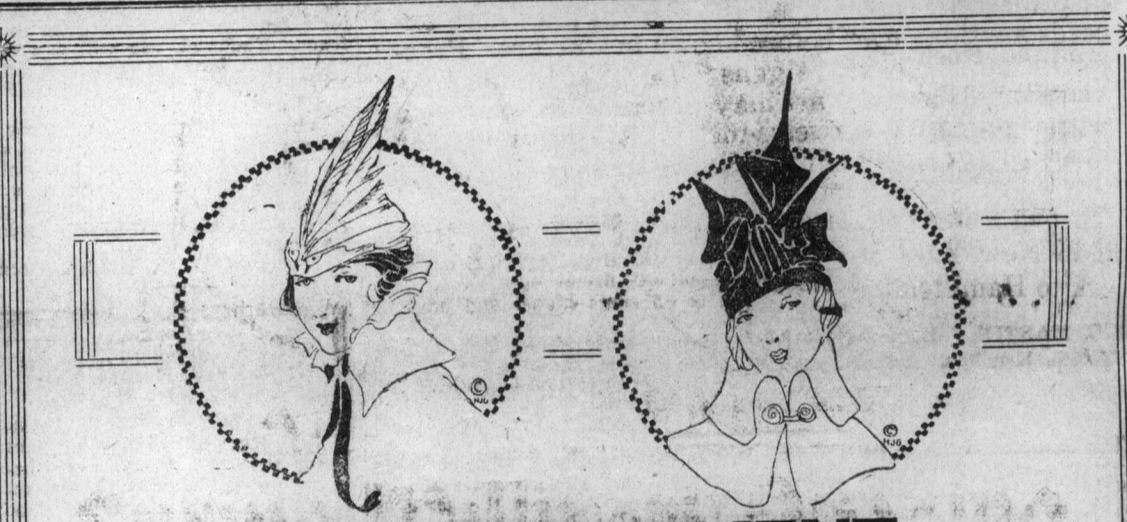
