David Burns, an old and respected resident of the 10th concession, died on Friday last. His age was 80 years. He had been ill only about twelve days. The funeral, which was largely attended, proceeded to Clinton cemetery on Sunday. He leaves a grown-up family. One son, who resides in Michigan, arrived only about an hour after the demise of his revered parent.—[Ex.]

A NEW TRIAL ASKED FOR.—At the assizes last week, Robt. Taylor, of Goderich township, got judgment against R. McCullagh for \$150 damages, arising out of a former trial. In the opinion of many this was even considered excessive, in view of the previous circumstances, but Mr. Taylor thinks the amount should have been larger and has given notice for a new trial. Whatever may have been the relation of the parties in the first place, these successive suits are certainly not raising the plaintiff in public esteem, and it is generally conceded that it would display wisdom on his part to cease them.—[New Era.]

West Wawanosis.

Council Hall, Oct. 17, 1885. Council met today, all members present. The reeve presiding. After the adoption of minutes of former meeting, the reeve called for appeals against by-law No. 7, of the present year. Messrs. Grierson & Balle contended that the engineer had not reported in accordance with wish of petition, but were willing to accept of report as given provided that the engineer allowed one box drain to be put through Mr. Grierson's lot instead of an open one, or the two boxed drains, as recommended in his report. In case Mr. Warren refuses to assent to this clerk was instructed to ask Mr. Warren to report to council the probable cost of opening ditch through N. H. of 16, on con. 3, as that is what petition called for. Mr. Anderson applied to council for outlet to water drained from his land as flow of water was obstructed by roads. Scott, King bridge, \$5.75. Council adjourned to meet on Saturday, Nov. 21st.
