## KOREA BOYCOTTS

## THE JAPANESE

Koreans Who Attend Their Schools Beheaded.

RUSSIA HAS A HAND IN TROUBLE

She Owns Timber Limits on the Yalu and Sends Troops to Protect Them.

Tokio, May 22.—The Korean Governor of Quelpart recently issued a proclamation "boycotting" Japanese residents, as not entitled to residence on the island, and declaring that any Korean attending a Japanese school should be beheaded. The Japanese consul at Mokpo was reinforced by police, and a Japanese warship went over and is said to have arrested matters satisfactorily. The governor is said to have acted under French influence. Discontent was manifested in diplomatic circles here by the announcement that the Korean Emperor had appointed a Belgian, Mr. Bohm, special adviser, a post held by Mr. Kato, a Japanese. Japanese Minister Washi has demanded that seniority of position be assured. The most serious trouble in Korea centers around a timber cutting contract held by the Russians on the Yalu River, on the borders of Russia. Japan has formed a pretext for importing troops nominally to protect the workmen. Japan has claimed a similar concession and negotiations are pending.

London, May 22.—The Morning Advertiser states that Mme. Melba, the Australian prima donna, is ill in Paris with an affection of the throat. Dr. Rees, the physician who attends the artists engaged for the Covent Garden Opera, has been summoned from London to examine her condition.
