GAMEY WORKS OFF SOME FRESH BILLINGSGATE

Pittsburg, Jan. 25. — An explosion occurred in the shaft of the Harwick Coal Company, near Cheswicks, Penn., on the West Pennsylvania railroad, about 4 a.m. today, causing all the escapees at least 125 miners who were at work. Three mine men were badly hurt and one will probably die.

At 10 o'clock Superintendent George Sheets said that he could not estimate the extent of the damage or how many men in the mine died. A messenger was hurried to Cheswick and to Springfield for physicians.

The number of men in the mine said to be larger than the first report, which gave 100 miners, including

The fire broke and a pit boss, it is said, was entombed. There are two shafts about 200 feet apart, and over 200 deep.

"The excitement is intense at Cripple Creek and Springdale, where the families live. Great crowds gathered around the pit mouth, and the women and children of the miners were in the streets. Three injured men were put on a train for Leavenworth and one died on his way there."

When the explosion occurred the confusion was so great that it is said no man was blown out of one of the shafts. It is not yet known what caused the explosion. The local physicians are at the mine.
