SOLDIERS SHAVED AND DUMPED IN TANK

Letter From Late Trooper Huston Describes Performance Crossing the Equator.

Mr. R. T. Dickie, of 395 Oxford street, has received a letter from Trooper George Huston, who was killed in the Hart's River battle. It was dated Newcastle, Natal, March 3, and describes the voyage from Halifax to Cape Town as being very pleasant, excepting the first four days out, when the weather was exceedingly rough and the boys experienced some trouble in finding an appetite.

He describes the visit paid the vessel by King Neptune as a very funny affair. The old fellow came on deck at a mule just as the vessel crossed the equator, and made a speech to which the major of the rifles responded in suitable terms. Then every man on board—officers and all—was shaved with a razor and a foot in length. Then he was thrown into a big tank of salt water.

The transport with the rifles on board anchored at Cape Town on Feb. 13, and proceeded from there to Durban, where the rifles were taken on shore. One of the latter was a trooper who fell on the deck and broke his leg. Only eight horses were lost on the trip. Since arriving at Newcastle the Canadians had been drilling steadily, and could scarcely get any leisure time. About 150 of the men went on a day's excursion to 20 miles to hold the trenches at Botha's Pass, but the Boers got through about 30 miles away, and no fighting took place. On another morning the rifles were ordered to leave camp about 4 o'clock, to be at another point at 6 o'clock for inspection by Lord Kitchener.

LIKELY LOOKING LOT OF TROTTERS AT PARK

Mr. Dan McEwen Has Some Fast Ones Training for Grand Circuit.

Dan McEwen, the well known trainer, has a dozen or so very likely trotters at the fair grounds track. He has been training them for grand circuit work for the last month. Other horsemen claim that they are the best lot he has had in years, which means that they will "do" something when they are campaigned. They are all Canadian animals, and some of the youngsters in his charge have done sensational work. WOMAN'S RELATION TO CHRISTIANITY

Discussed at an Interesting Meeting of Local Baptist Women's Circles.

The union meeting of the Baptist Women's Mission Circles of the city was held in the Adelaide Street Church yesterday afternoon and evening.

The afternoon meeting was presided over by Mrs. (Rev.) T. S. Johnson and was of more than usual interest, as there were representatives from the other denominations, telling what women are doing in their respective churches. Mrs. Sage, of the Anglican Church, said she took Mrs. Boomer's place by request of that lady, whose health was such that she had been advised to suspend all work and seek a complete change of scene and climate for at least two years. Mrs. Sage's paper gave a concise history of their women's work from 1815, and they were allowed to attend meetings, and immediately after to help in the work of carrying the Gospel to the colonies of Great Britain and foreign countries, until the present time.

Mrs. Fraser told of the great and progressive work the Presbyterian women were doing in the different parts of the world.

Mrs. McNeel, of Dundas Street Church, whose heart and life are overflowing with love for those who are in the darkness of heathendom, spoke of the work of their schools, colleges, hospitals, and the great extension of their twentieth century fund allowed them to make. More of their work will be heard of at the conference, which is to be held here about the middle of April.

Mrs. McNeel told of the work of the Baptists in India, Bolivia, Quebec, New Ontario, and the Indian reserves.

Mrs. Wells' Bible reading was of Mary's and Martha's service of listening and serving.

Tea and sociability occupied the time between the meetings.

At 8 o'clock Mrs. Johnson again took the chair. After singing, Mr. Baker led in prayer, and Mrs. Baker, of Harding Hall, spoke of the "Dayman Between Us and God."

Rev. W. Hartley, of St. Thomas, gave an address on "Woman's Place in Christianity and Her Debt to It." Where Christ reigned woman was uplifted to be the equal of man; and her successful work for the down-trodden women of heathen countries was the discharge of her indebtedness.

The singing, which was led by the Talbot Street Church choir, was an interesting feature of the evening meeting. Mrs. Arthur Brown's pleasing solos, both afternoon and evening, were fully appreciated.
