GERMAN NAVY. Emperor William Seems Pleased With the Progress Made.

Berlin, Nov. 18.—Emperor William today participated in the debate of the subject of Naval Engineers on the subject of placing heavy guns on little ships and its effect upon their designs and construction...

His Majesty's interest in the influence of military requirements upon the development of ship construction and artillery, pointed out how the aim of Germany had always been to allow the opinion of the officers who had to navigate ships to have as much weight and influence as the shipbuilder and the constructor.

The Emperor illustrating his contention that tactical requirements influenced the construction of ships of war, said the lines of the galleys were superior in this respect to later battleships. He instanced the battle of Lepanto as the greatest wherein galleys had been engaged, and said Don Juan of Austria had brought his galleys into action in half moon formation, and had destroyed the enemy's fleet by the superiority of their bow fire.
