## LADIES' DAY AT BUFFALO.

HOW C. J. HAMILTON FILLED HIS GRAND STAND.

Fantasy No. Match for Azote—Village Farm's Azote Captures the 2000.

Parade in the 2:30 Trot—Tommy Britton Won the 2:30 Class and El Hami the 2:35 Event.

Buffalo, Aug. 14.—This was ladies' day at the Grand Circuit races, so Mr. Hamilton filled his grand stand to the top.

The advertised event, which attracted all attention was the match race between Azote and Fantasy. Most horsemen expected that Mr. Hamilton would not let Fantasy race on account of her bad foot, due to the accident at Cleveland. When she did come on the track the odds were all against her. Andy Welch offered fifty to five against her, and refused any money on Azote, so the bettors used it as an exhibition race. And so it began. Geers drove Fantasy, and McLeod drove Azote. When Azote began moving in the stretch, the mare could not keep the pace and finished two lengths behind Azote. The second heat was trotted in much the same time.

El Hami took three straight heats in the 2:35 class trotting with Valley Queen, finishing second each time. Geers did most masterly driving in the 2:30 trot, winning the \$2000 purse for Village Farm with the black stallion Athol. Athol was the favorite at even money. Miss McGregor had the pole in the first heat and the Hamlin colt got the third best in the 1:07 1/2. Here Geers brought Athol to the front and at the stretch he was in line with Lady Wilton and Miss McGregor.

The race was exciting, Athol taking the heat from Lady Wilton by a head. Miss McGregor finished third. Lady Wilton pushed Athol hard in the second heat, but failed by half a length, and the Hamlin colt got the third best in an exciting race with Miss McGregor.
