

for each patient, and \$5 a week for their nurse's board. Several reasons induced, or rather necessitated, a change: first, the intervention of the Indian village, always offensive, and sometimes dangerous, for the visiting ladies; secondly, the difficulty of carrying out their own arrangements in another establishment, to which may be added divided medical opinions as to the salubrity of the site. Under these circumstances, the Ladies' Committee removed their patients from the Royal Hospital, and, by the aid of the public, have erected a handsome building on a noble site, where they are gratified to inform the subscribers they have been able to provide for their patients at nearly the same cost as at the Royal Hospital.

The refusal of the House of Assembly to grant the sum of \$250, in lieu of a similar sum voted by them last year in aid of the Building Fund, but not paid, has entailed some inconvenience on the Managers, inasmuch as, relying on this grant, they incurred expenses which they would either have avoided, or have provided other means of defraying. The debt of the site and Building Fund is now \$
