





CHOCOLATE CAKE.—One cupful of butter, two cupsful of sugar, three and one-half cupsful of flour, three teaspoonsful of baking powder, one scant cupful of sweet milk and five eggs, leasured the second ving out the whites of two; bake in a dripping pan, and when nearly cool pour on the frosting made of the whites of the two eggs, one and onehalf cupsful of sugar, two teaspoonsful of vanilla and six tablespoonsful of grated chocolate beaten together.

TAPIOCA PUDDING-Take six tablespoonsful of tapioca and soak it in milk for some hours before you intend to use When you are going to make your pudding put the tapioca into a quart of milk, place it on the fire, and as soon es it boils sweeten to your taste and let it simmer for a quarter of an hour. Pour it into a basin and stir in a little fresh butter and three eggs well beaten. Bake one-half hour.

BRAN SOUP WITHOUT MEAT. -- Parboil one pint of beans, drain off the water and add fresh, and let boil until tender, season with salt and pepper, add a piece of butter the size of a walnut, or more if preferred; when done skim out half the beans, leaving the broth and the remaining half of the beans; now add a teacupful of cream or rich milk, a dozen or more crackers broken up; let it boil up and serve.


