

KING v. GARCIA—ORDE, J.—JAN. 19.

Wages—Money Lent—Action to Recover—Evidence—Findings of Trial Judge.—Action to recover certain sums alleged to be due to the plaintiff for wages and for money lent. The action was tried without a jury at a Toronto sittings. ORDE, J., in a written judgment, said that the plaintiff's claim for wages was made up of a large number of items spread over a period of 5 years, ending in September, 1919, credit being given for moneys received from the defendant from time to time, and allowances being made to the defendant for board for part of the period. The amount alleged to have been lent was \$123. The learned Judge reviewed the evidence, and found that the plaintiff was entitled to recover \$1,864.20, including interest from the date of the issue of the writ of summons until the date of this judgment, and directed that judgment should be entered for the plaintiff for that sum and the costs of the action. ROBINSON v. TORONTO GENERAL TRUSTS CORPORATION—
MASTEN, J.—JAN. 20.

Injunction—Interim Order—Terms.—Motion by the plaintiffs for an interim injunction restraining the defendants from holding meetings of the shareholders of the Arena Gardens Limited. The motion was heard in the Weekly Court, Toronto. MASTEN, J., in a written judgment, said that certain orders made by other Judges in the action of Toronto General Trusts Corporation v. Arena Gardens Limited did not constitute an adjudication of the question arising on this motion. He was of opinion that, on the usual undertaking, an interim injunction should be granted, in the terms of the notice of motion, to continue until the trial of the action. The plaintiffs must be on terms to deliver their statement of claim forthwith and to speed the action in every way.
