There are a limited number of teaching assistant positions available which do not require the same level of qualifications.

There are limited employment opportunities with other embassies. The jobs available tend to be primarily secretarial or clerical in nature.

There is a high demand for English language instruction in Jakarta and thus there are good prospects for any spouse with certification in Teaching English as a Foreign Language (TEFL or ESL). Until now, most of the employment opportunities in TEFL have been with the British Council or Australian Language Council. However, there may be increasing possibilities for qualified TEFL teachers to work in association with the CIDA program which will be expanding its involvement in human resource development considerably over the next few years.
