## PART III—Logistics and Administration

- 18. Canada shall:
  - a. let the Federal Republic of Germany have for its use the buildings and installations annotated in Annex B and shall maintain these buildings and installations in accordance with Canadian standards:
  - b. make available the buildings and construction services agreed on in Annex B as well as all the buildings and services that may be agreed on in the future between the Ministry of Defence and the Department of National Defence; and
  - c. make available, where possible, unfurnished married and permanent single quarters under the conditions and at the rates applicable to Canadian Forces personnel.

19. At the request of the Federal Republic of Germany, Canada shall make available to or procure on behalf of the Federal Republic of Germany or assist the Federal Republic of Germany in procuring its requirements, which, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, shall include

- a. radio frequencies and communication links;
- b. kitchen and dining equipment;
- c. foodstuffs and canteen supplies;
- d. POL;
- e. furniture and furnishings;
- f. maps of the training grounds, trigonometrical lists and other surveying documents;
- g. hard targets, target material and other ancillary range items;
- h. winter clothing;
- i. medical material; and
- j. civilian workers and civilian guards.
- 20. Canada shall, if requested, assist the Federal Republic of Germany in:
  - a. the procurement of facilities and services at Winnipeg International Airport for use as an airhead for military and civilian charter aircraft for transporting personnel and freight between places outside Canada and CFB SHILO;

- b. the procurement of facilities and services at agreed entry and exit ports for tracked and other vehicles, equipment and supplies, including ammunition;
- c. the transportation of the items listed in b., including supervision of the transportation from the port of discharge to CFB SHILO:
- d. the procurement of facilities and services for special training (adventure training), the type and scope of which shall be agreed upon between the Base Commander at CFB SHILO and the head of the German Liaison Staff;
- e. obtaining the use of commercial buses, on a contract basis, for the transportation of personnel as and when required; and
- f. making the arrangements for medical and dental as well as educational (school) and religious care.
