The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Paul Martin, announced today in Paris that, in conformity with its desire to enhance cultural exchanges between Canada and France, the Canadian Government has decided to make a \$45,000 grant to the Maison Canadienne at the Cité Universitaire of Paris to help the management of that institution pay the cost of urgent repairs needed for the improvement of students' living conditions.

The Maison Canadienne is a student residence situated in the Cité Universitaire where many countries maintain similar institutions. It accommodates 71 students from all the provinces of Canada and, in accordance with the custom of the Cité Universitaire, a few students from foreign countries.
