

Public Service Superannuation Act, Bills:

1. Resolution,—To provide for the payment of death benefits up to a maximum of five thousand dollars for the spouse, or the estate of a public servant, etc.: House to consider in committee of the whole at its next sitting, 644. Resolution adopted, 648. Bill No. 463, Mr. Abbott, An Act to amend the Public Service Superannuation Act; 1st R., 648. 2nd R., moved, 656. Amendment, Mr. Macdonnell (Greenwood),—That the subject-matter be referred to the Banking and Commerce Committee, moved and negatived (yeas 36; nays 125), 656-7. 2nd R., agreed to (yeas 125; nays 36) 657. Referred to *Banking and Commerce Committee*, 658. Reported with amendments, 713 (Ninth Report); Evidence recorded as Appendix No. 11 to the *Journals*. Reported from committee of the whole, 750. 3rd R., moved, 750. Amendment, Mr. Macdonnell (Greenwood),—That Bill be read this day six months hence; negatived (yeas 32; nays 114), 750. 3rd R., agreed to (yeas 114; nays 32), 751-2. Passed by Senate with amendments, 817. Amendments agreed to, on division, 819. R.A., 866. (2-3 Elizabeth II, Chapter 64.)

Resolution,—To amend certain Acts relating to several Crown Corporations in order to prescribe the pension provisions and the manner in which such pension provisions are to apply to persons transferred from the Public Service to Corporations: House to consider in committee of the whole at its next sitting, 452. Resolution adopted, 645. Bill No. 461, Mr. Abbott, An Act to amend certain Acts respecting the Superannuation of government employees transferred to Crown Corporations; 1st R., 645. 2nd R., after debate, 698. Reported from committee of the whole, 698. 3rd R., by leave, 698. Passed by Senate, 730. R.A., 736. (2-3 Elizabeth II, Chapter 44.)
