QUEBEC PROVINCIAL FLAG

Question No. 1,520—**Mr. Herbert:**

On which buildings in the province of Quebec does the government fly the Quebec provincial flag in addition to the Canadian flag?

Hon. Yvon Pinard (President of the Privy Council): In so far as Public Works Canada is concerned, the government does not fly the Quebec provincial flag, in addition to the Canadian flag, on government buildings managed by the Department of Public Works.

In so far as Transport Canada is concerned, in addition to the Canadian flag, the Quebec provincial flag is flown on Canadian Air Transportation administration premises
